Who, When, What, Where and other details

WHO: Anyone who plays a concert band instrument, SVers and friends/family. People new to the group need to be pretty quick at learning music, as we have only 6 rehearsals.

WHEN: Rehearsals: May 28, June 4, 11, 18, 25, July 2, 6:45–8:15 PM.

Gig: Thursday, July 3 - Wayland COA summer concert series, 6:30 call for 7:00 outdoor concert behind the Wayland Town Building. The strings will NOT be playing with us for this concert; they have a separate summer program.

WHAT: Summer Band: 6 rehearsals and a performance (7 sessions). Rehearsals will be indoors and the concert will be outdoors.

MUSIC We will be playing 9 or 10 pieces for our outdoor concert on July 3rd, to be chosen from the following (most are fairly easy):

- ♪ Darklands March (spring 2025)
- ♪ Holst Hymn (spring 2025)
- ♪ General Greene March (played in fall 2016, summer 2017 & 2019)
- ♪ Johnny B. Goode (played in 2010)
- ♪ Alexander's Ragtime Band (played in 2016) (trumpet section feature, so it depends on whether we have enough trumpets)
- ♪ Take Me Out to the Ball Game (permanent folder)
- ♪ "America the Beautiful" from American Folk Song Celebration (summer 2024)

You will find your parts for the music in the same dropbox for your instrument where you accessed other SV music. We will send out an email and let you know when the summer music is available in the dropbox. Any questions or problems, please email Diane.

WHERE: Band rehearsals will be in the Large Hearing Room at the Wayland Town Building.
BRING A MUSIC STAND. Chairs provided.

July 3 concert is also at the Town Building outdoors behind the building (unless the new community center is open by then, in which case it may be there...)

Cost: \$100 for all 7 sessions or \$20 per session drop-in – cash or check.

Registration: is through SVNHM, **NOT LS Adult Ed** (they don't have a summer program).

Bring to rehearsals: Bring your music stand, instrument, music, pencil, & love of making music!
Brass and other instruments that drip water – also please bring a rag or something to empty on.

Restroom access: Yes!

Arrival: You may arrive any time after 6:20 and hang out to chat at the end of rehearsal.
If you are able, please help us put away chairs after rehearsal.


